



COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FUNDACIÓN PARA EL FUTURO DE COLOMBIA
AND
TILBURG UNIVERSITY

Tilburg University of the Netherlands and *Fundación para el Futuro de Colombia* (COLFUTURO) of the Republic of Colombia hereinafter designated as "The Parties";

DECLARE:

Preamble:

Since the original agreement between the Parties was signed in January 2007, both Tilburg University and COLFUTURO have worked in a highly cooperative manner for their mutual benefit. In recognition of the existing and mutual beneficial relationship between Tilburg University and COLFUTURO, and in support of their aims of the COLFUTURO Programa Semilleros, the Parties agree that:

Tilburg University will provide 1 scholarship of EUR 13,000 for living expenses (including, round trip flight, health insurance, rent for housing, food, study books) and a tuition waiver of up to EUR\$14,000 to one eligible student in any of the Master of Science programs of Tilburg School of Economics and Management for the academic year 2016-2017

1. Students in Colombia interested in this Scholarship will seek admission to the Master's degree programs offered by Tilburg University School of Economics and Management, following the normal application procedures and meeting all the standard admission requirements (including official language tests) established by Tilburg University.
2. The potential candidates will be from COLFUTURO's *Programa Semilleros*.
3. The selection of the recipient of the scholarship will be decided by Tilburg University, COLFUTURO will provide a list of the potential candidates.
4. The potential candidates must have successfully completed the established COLFUTURO selection process.
5. The student must be in receipt of an unconditional offer letter from Tilburg University for a master's program of the School of Economics and Management. The student must have obtained the offer via the usual graduate application and selection procedure.
6. COLFUTURO agrees to advise Tilburg University of their nominated students by 15th July at the latest.
7. Tilburg University reserves the right to refuse the nomination proposed by COLFUTURO, in which case COLFUTURO will be required to nominate another potential candidate.
